



Ethical Easter Eggs

Its time to start thinking about where to source your ethical Easter eggs for Easter 2019!

Fortunately, there are a bunch of different options fair trade options which means they are made without modern slavery in their supply chains. For example, the Moser Roth mini Easter eggs (available from ALDI) are fair trade. Alternatively Oxfam stocks fair trade Easter eggs as well as a range of fair trade chocolate products. The Fairtrade (http://fairtrade.com.au/) website has a list of several brands that sell certified fair trade chocolate available from a range of online and instore retailers—however pay attention while buying as not necessarily all products from the listed brands are fair trade.
